Last week the word "remain" was repeated over and over in the second reading and the Gospel. This week the word is "love." In both his first letter and his Gospel, John writes, "love one another." It is a command to all Jesus' disciples, from the Apostles at the Last Supper to all of us gathered around the table of the Lord today. To love one another as we are loved by God is what we are called to do.

It is typical to think of love as a feeling, the way we feel about a spouse, a parent, a child, a close friend; but Jesus uses it in a permanent condition. Love becomes a part of one's character. As a part of our character, it can't help but flow out of us when we interact with others.

We are also in the month of May and our reflections of love turn to our Blessed Mother. Mary teaches us how to remain in the love of God. In our Marian devotions, we pray to her for her intercession.
