From Pastor's Desk**

We are called to be disciples. What does it mean to be a disciple? Today's Gospel describes what Jesus told His disciples when He sent them out: what to bring, what to leave behind, what to say, what to do. Jesus sends us out facing challenges and hardships being His followers.

Fr. Adam Sedar, the new Secretary for Clergy in our Diocese just offered our priests some sound advice as he begins his new ministry. His advice can also be applied to each of us as we go out as Jesus' disciples who at times experience difficulties.

- Remember to pray especially before the Blessed Sacrament for a little time each day.
- St. Francis said "It is in giving that we receive." Do random acts of kindness and reach out to those who might be lonely like the elderly or the sick.
- Remember those who love you and care for you. Often our problems mar our vision of seeing that things aren't as bad as we think. So don't become so self-absorbed that you forget to feel loved.

PREP/CCD: A child preparing to receive any Sacrament must be a practicing Catholic and in a Religious Education Program for two consecutive years immediately prior to receiving the Sacrament. **CCD/PREP families must be registered parishioners. Bishop's Annual Appeal Update

We are grateful to our parishioners who have already made a donation or pledge to the Bishop's Annual Appeal. So far this year, we have raised or pledged \$4,610.00 from 65 donors. Last year our parish raised \$6,102.00 from 92 donors. As pastor my only hope and goal is that we as a parish can raise the same amount as last year.

Making a six-month pledge to the Appeal allows you to maximize the amount that you may give by making monthly payments. For example, a \$300 gift to the BAA may be set-up with six \$50 installments. Your sacrifice and generosity to those less fortunate will allow the ministries of our Diocese to offer services to those who need our assistance. Parish Religious Education Program (PREP)

The kids just finished school less than 2 weeks ago, but it is necessary for us to begin planning and preparing for our next school year and religious education. We are in need of hall monitors to sit in the halls near the bathrooms to make sure our children are safe. Hall monitors can bring a book or a laptop while performing this duty.

We are in need of classroom aides to assist our catechists in those classes where there are a large number of children or projects needing help or supervision.

We could always use some more catechists or substitutes to teach our young people. How can we expect our children to pass on the faith if we do not pass it on to them?

All these positions will require compliance with State and Diocesan Codes of Conduct. While not extensive, it will take some time to receive back clearance checks. Therefore, it helps if we begin now. For more information please speak with Tom Dowd, Fr. Bill, or Mary Ann Lubinsky.
